General information on partnering with DGF Ltd

Doing Good Foundation works with families in need to help them achieve home ownership. It does this by partnering with them for up to 5 years. Families must put in 500 hours of their own labour to help build the home, this is called sweat equity. Once completed they rent the property from DGF Ltd and if they keep to their tenancy agreement, DGF Ltd will gift back all the net rents (after deducting operating costs e.g. rates, insurance, repairs etc.). The gifted back rent is used as a deposit for the purchase of the home, this usually happens after 5 years, but can be sooner. This enables the family to raise a bank mortgage for the balance, purchase the home from DGF Ltd and complete their journey to home ownership.

Families are considered who meet the following criteria;

- Lived in Tauranga area for more than 2 years
- Have 2 dependent children or more
- NZ Citizen or NZ Residency
- Never owned a home
- Steady employment with moderate income
- Enrolled or willing to enrol in Kiwisaver
- Demonstrate charitable need
- Have no serious criminal convictions or charges pending
- Be able to show evidence of a good tenancy and credit history
- Have waited two years after being discharged from bankruptcy or NAP, and have re-established a good credit rating
- Stable credit history
- Prepared to commit 500 sweat equity hours during the building process
